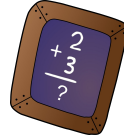

READING WORKSHOP

We are continuing our Mystery Unit. We are using the elements of mystery to be on alert for clues, suspects, and culprits as we read. Reading mysteries helps students further develop important skills, like inferring, close reading, and creating theories. We are revising our theories and suspects based on collecting new clues and evidence.



MATH

We are practicing for the New York State Math Exam. When the exam is completed we will return to some bar modeling using all four operations, adding, subtracting, multiplying, and dividing. We will also return to graphs, and introduce line plots.
