

MS. ROBINSON-RISI'S CLASS Welcome to Kindergarten!

We will have a Meet and Greet on August 30th at 11:30 AM (sharp)!

Please review information sent to you by the Parkville Main Office for details about Meet and Greet.

Your child's supplies should be brought to Meet and Greet in a large shopping bag.

Please clearly label the bag with your child's name and my name.

I am so excited to meet everyone in our class! What a wonderful year we're going to have together!

Here's a list of additional suggested supplies, specifically for our class in addition to the <u>Universal Supply List</u> for Kindergarten (on the following page).

1 clear, zippered pencil case (or a fabric one with a plastic "window") to hold crayons (label outside with a Sharpie marker)
2 ADDITIONAL <i>plastic</i> pocket folders with "3 hole-fasteners" inside (Total folders, including the 'generic" Kindergarten list should be 2 regular and 4 of the "3-hole fastener" type). Please make sure you get 6 different colors. Write your child's name on the TOP RIGHT of EACH folder with a Sharpie marker.
1 package of clear plastic page protectors (at least 25 sheets, thicker plastic works best)
an envelope with \$7.50 (cash) for Scholastic News, a children's educational publication (Make sure your child's NAME and SCHOLASTIC NEWS is written on the outside of the envelope).
1 (close-up) 4x6 photo of your child. (Write your child's name on the back of the photo).

SPECIAL NOTES:

- 1. Pencils, colored pencils, thick markers and thin markers (requested on the "Universal" Kindergarten list): PLEASE WRITE YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON **EACH** PENCIL AND MARKER WITH A SHARPIE SO IF THEY FALL ON THE FLOOR, YOUR CHILD CAN IDENTIFY THEM. Do NOT write your child's name on dry erase markers, felt-tipped pens, erasers, or glue sticks (on the "Universal" list), as I will store them in a large container and distribute them, as needed, to students.
- 2. As stated in the "Universal" Kindergarten list, please send an adult sized T-SHIRT as your child's smock. Write your child's name with a Sharpie marker on the neck of the shirt. (Store-bought smocks are not as easy for the children to manage as a large t-shirt, so please send the T-SHIRT, only). PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING.

We would greatly appreciate donations of **Ziploc bags** in the "2-gallon " size! THANK YOU!


Welcome to Kindergarten! 2023-2024

The following are suggested supplies you may wish to bring with you to school in September:

{If purchasing school supplies places a hardship on your family, supplies will be provided.}

- 1 <u>standard-sized</u> elementary **backpack** (no wheels please)
- 1 hard plastic pencil box to store supplies in school (suggested size, 8" x 5", no larger than 9" x 6")
- 1 adult-sized t-shirt to use as a **smock** for art
- 1 change of clothes (including underwear & socks) in a labeled
 Ziploc bag ~ please label each clothing item



- 1 box of long Crayola colored pencils, sharpened and 1 box of Crayola crayons (24 count)
- 1 multi-pack each of small and large glue sticks and 1 bottle of Elmer's school glue
- 15" safety **scissor**, blunt (*Fiskars* brand, if possible)
- 1 box of pre-sharpened #2 **pencils** with erasers (12 count, *Ticonderoga* if possible)
- 6-12 low-odor, thin, black dry erase markers (Expo brand)
- 8 black **felt-tipped pens** (*PaperMate* Flair, if possible)
- 2 plastic (not plastic coated) folders with inside bottom pockets
- 2 plastic pocket folders with 3-hole fasteners inside, one blue and one red
- 1 **Primary Journal Creative Story Tablet** (Mead brand, K 2, picture space on top/primary lines below)
- 1 on/over the ear adjustable band **headphones** (no earbuds, please; remove from packaging and label and place in a labeled Ziploc bag)
- 1 box of tissues and 1 package of baby wipes

In addition, a <u>donation</u> of any of the following items would be greatly appreciated: a box of snack size, sandwich or quart size, or 1 or 2-gallon *Ziploc baggies*; a roll of paper towels; a box of plastic spoons or forks; a box of clear sheet protectors; white paper plates, any size, non-coated, please (*Chinet* brand, if possible)
