



Dear Families,

Hello and welcome to Kindergarten! I look forward to a wonderful year together. The children will grow, flourish and make meaningful friendships! Below are a few items that would be very helpful to bring with you on the first day in addition to the generic Kindergarten list. **All supplies are shared by all so there is no need to label each item.** 

- -6 Avery Glue Sticks (1.27 oz)
- -1 Plastic Shoe Box for locker storage
- -2 Boxes of Ziploc Storage Bags Gallon Size
- -2 Boxes of Ziploc Storage Bags Quart Size
- -2 Bottles of Pump Hand Soap

<u>Lunch and Snack-</u> Please label lunch bags/boxes with your child's name. Your child needs a healthy snack and a drink each day. If your child is bringing a lunch from home please label the lunch and snack separately so that your child knows what to eat at snack and lunch time.

<u>Extra Clothing-P</u>lease send in an extra set of clothing for your child: including one shirt, one pair of pants and shorts, one pair of socks and one pair of underpants. **Label all clothing** with your child's name.

**Backpack-** (bring on the first day of school) Your child's backpack should be big enough to fit a folder. Backpacks with wheels are not permitted.

**Smock-** You child will need a smock for art labeled with your child's name. An oversized t-shirt works great!

I am looking forward to meeting you and your child at our **Kindergarten Meet & Greet** on **Wednesday, August 30th** at **11:30 AM** in our **Parkville Classroom, Room 25**. Please bring your child's school supplies and other items on the supply lists to Meet & Greet so that everything will be ready for the **first day of school, Tuesday, September 5th** (which will be a full day of school.) I know that we will all have a terrific year together!

## 2023-2024

The following are suggested supplies you may wish to bring with you to school in September:

{If purchasing school supplies places a hardship on your family, supplies will be provided.}

- 1 <u>standard-sized</u> elementary **backpack** (no wheels please)
- 1 hard **plastic pencil box** to store supplies in school (suggested size, 8" x 5", no larger than 9" x 6")
- 1 adult-sized t-shirt to use as a smock for art
- 1 change of clothes (including underwear & socks) in a labeled
  Ziploc bag ~ please label each clothing item



- 1 box of thick and 1 box of thin Crayola washable markers (not scented please, 10 count)
- 1 box of long Crayola colored pencils, sharpened and 1 box of Crayola crayons (24 count)
- 1 multi-pack each of small and large glue sticks and 1 bottle of Elmer's school glue
- 1 5" safety scissor, blunt (Fiskars brand, if possible)
- 1 box of pre-sharpened #2 **pencils** with erasers (12 count, *Ticonderoga* if possible)
- 6-12 low-odor, <u>thin</u>, black dry erase markers (*Expo* brand)
- 8 black **felt-tipped pens** (*PaperMate* Flair, if possible)
- 2 plastic (not plastic coated) folders with inside bottom pockets
- 2 plastic pocket folders with 3-hole fasteners inside, one blue and one red
- 1 **Primary Journal Creative Story Tablet** (Mead brand, K 2, picture space on top/primary lines below)
- 1 on/over the ear adjustable band **headphones** (no earbuds, please; remove from packaging and label and place in a labeled Ziploc bag)
- 1 box of tissues and 1 package of baby wipes

In addition, a <u>donation</u> of any of the following items would be greatly appreciated: a box of snack size, sandwich or quart size, or 1 or 2 gallon *Ziploc baggies*; a roll of paper towels; a box of plastic spoons or forks; a box of clear sheet protectors; white paper plates, any size, non-coated, please (*Chinet* brand, if possible)
