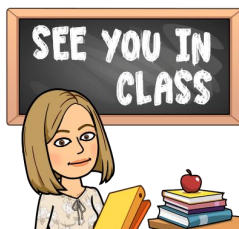
Dear New Kindergarten Friends,

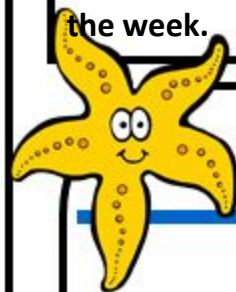
• Please send in:

Meet and Greet

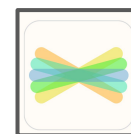
- Meet and Greet will take place on Wednesday, August 30st from 11:30 - 12:00. Mrs. Bell will send an important email with more information about the event.
- Please bring any supplies that you have ready on this day in a clean, reusable bag labeled with your child's name. The rest may be sent in throughout the week.



Tech-Related



- Download Seesaw on a tablet or computer.



- At another time, I will give you information regarding other apps your child may need/want to use at home.

- I will be sharing photos and files throughout the year in Google Drive. In some cases, it may be helpful if at least one family member has a Google Gmail account.



If you don't have one, you may wish to consider creating one for you or your whole family.



Backpack & Lunch/Snack

- Your child's backpack should be **LARGE** enough so that it will easily zip around his/her binder. Most Pre-K backpacks tend to be too small. Backpacks with wheels are not permitted.
- It is recommended that your child have a lunch bag to use for snack, regardless of whether he/she will eat lunch from school or from home.
- Reusable, leak-proof water bottles that LOCK are best. Please make sure your child knows how to securely shut the bottle's lid.
- If sending in a bag or box drink, teach your child how to properly insert the straw.
- A snack and a drink should be sent beginning the first day of school - Tuesday, Sept. 5th.
- Please label backpacks, lunch bags, and water bottles.

Home Binder

A half-inch, 3-ring binder has been requested in the *Additional Supplies* section. We will be using this for our home binder (rather than just using a folder). It will allow me to send home sight word cards, academic resources, as well as nightly homework assignments.

I will provide more information on how we'll use this binder at our Open House meeting.

Scholastic Let's Find Out

- Throughout the year, we will be using the Scholastic magazine, *Let's Find Out*. (Digital and hard copies.)

Please send \$7 cash, in an envelope marked "Let's Find Out" and your child's name. Due mid-September.



Miscellaneous

Your child will also need:

- One old, adult-sized, **LONG-sleeved** shirt - to be used as a smock (labeled). ****Please cut the sleeves so that they end at your child's wrists.** (No short-sleeved or plastic smocks.)



- Two extra sets of clothing (one for the warm weather and one set for the winter). Please include socks and underwear.

- To help keep your child's locker neat, please send the extra clothing in a 6-quart plastic shoebox with lid. Sterilite brand fits well. The height should be no higher than around 5". A second box will be needed to store extra supplies.

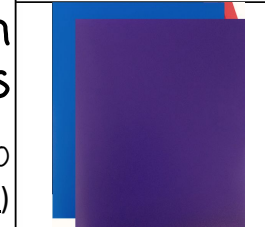

1 - pack, unruled

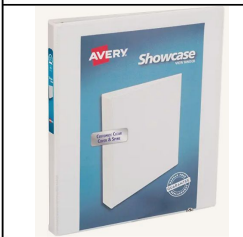


6-quart Plastic shoebox
