Welcome to Kindergarten!

We will have a Meet and Greet on August 30th at 12:30 PM (sharp). Please review information sent to you by the Parkville Main Office for details about Meet and Greet. Your child's supplies should be brought to Meet and Greet in a large shopping bag. Please clearly label the bag with your child's name and my name.

What a wonderful year we're going to have in Room 205! Here's a list of suggested supplies for our class that are not on the Universal Supply List for Kindergarten. Our Kindergarten class will be able to participate in a special "Meet and Greet" on August 30th at 12:30 PM (sharp). Please check your emails from Parkville for more information. We are going to have an exciting year!

\_\_\_\_\_ 1 clear, zippered pencil case (or a fabric one with a plastic "window") to hold crayons (label outside with a Sharpie marker)

\_\_\_\_\_ 2 ADDITIONAL **plastic pocket folders** with "3 hole-fasteners" inside (Total folders, including the "generic" Kindergarten list should be 2 regular and 4 of the "3-hole fastener" type). Please make sure you get **6 different colors**. Write your child's name on the **TOP RIGHT** of EACH folder with a Sharpie marker.

\_\_\_\_\_ 1 package of clear **plastic page protectors** (at least 25 sheets, thicker plastic works best)

\_\_\_\_\_ an envelope with \$7.50 (**cash**) for **Scholastic News**, a children's educational publication (Make sure your child's NAME and SCHOLASTIC NEWS is written on the outside of the envelope).

**1 (close-up) 4x6 photo** of your child. (Write your child's name on the back of the photo).

## SPECIAL NOTES:

1. *Pencils, colored pencils, thick markers and thin markers* (requested on the "Universal" Kindergarten list): PLEASE WRITE YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON **EACH** PENCIL AND MARKER WITH A SHARPIE SO IF THEY FALL ON THE FLOOR, YOUR CHILD CAN IDENTIFY THEM. Do NOT write your child's name on dry erase markers, felt-tipped pens, erasers, or glue sticks (on the "Universal" list), as I will store them in a large container and distribute them, as needed, to students.

2. As stated in the "Universal" Kindergarten list, please send an adult sized T-SHIRT as your child's smock. Write your child's name with a Sharpie marker on the neck of the shirt. (Store-bought smocks are not as easy for the children to manage as a large t-shirt, so please send the T-SHIRT, only).
