Dear Parents/Guardians,

The end of the 21-22 school year is fast approaching. The close of a school year can be a busy time for our students and faculty as they prepare for regents and final exams. We encourage all of our students to continue to work hard and remain focused on their success.

Courses that do NOT culminate in a Regents examination will require students to take a final exam in that subject. Some final exams will be given during class time; others will be scheduled during the two weeks following the last day of classes.

All students should clear their obligations before the last day of school. All textbooks, library books, and school equipment must be returned. Students should check with their teachers to be sure that all obligations are cleared. They should be aware that all books and equipment presently in use must be returned before school ends. **Lockers must be emptied by Friday, June 10.** Please have your child bring home all personal items before that date. This is also a good time for them to check in the lost and found for abandoned items they may have forgotten about. **Anything left in lockers after June 14 will be discarded.**

The English, Math, Science, Social Studies and World Languages Departments will be offering extra review sessions during the week. North High will also offer review sessions - please check the North High website for those dates and times. Students whose teachers feel may need additional review will be notified individually. Students who fail a Regents or a course will be notified by the Guidance Department as this becomes evident. Counselors will discuss procedures for addressing failed courses and/or arranging for summer school classes.
