Monday

Title: **It's All Greek To Me!**

Grade(s): 2nd – 5th

Day: Monday

Fee: \$100, Reg. Max: 15

Description: Learn about all things Greek! We will go on a journey to Ancient Greece and dive into the world of Greek mythology. Greek mythology is not only interesting, but it is also the foundation of allusion and character genesis in literature. The class will also include an introduction to the Greek language, including words we use in English that stem from Greek words (etymology) and other aspects of Greek culture including dance and food. Let your imagination take you on a weekly trip through time!

Brain Games promote logical thinking, spatial awareness, deductive reasoning and strategy. Games include mathematics, logic and wordplay. Students can choose from independent activities, partner play or friendly competition. Chess will be offered as a club within Brain Games. Any children interested in playing chess do not require prior experience. All levels of ability are welcome. Playing chess has been proven to directly contribute to academic performance. In Brain Games & Chess, students will see the fun in exercising their brain!



Title: Reading Recipes

Title: Stock Market Game

Description: What would you do if you were given \$100,000? Would you spend it all at once? Would you think about putting some of it in the bank? By participating in the Stock Market Game, you will gain a fundamental understanding of investing and how you might get your money to work for you. Online Registration Instruction:

1. Register on-line through FamilyID <https://www.familyid.com/great-neck-school-year-enrichment-programs>
2. To find your program, click on the link provided by the Organization above and select the registration form under the word *Programs*.
